

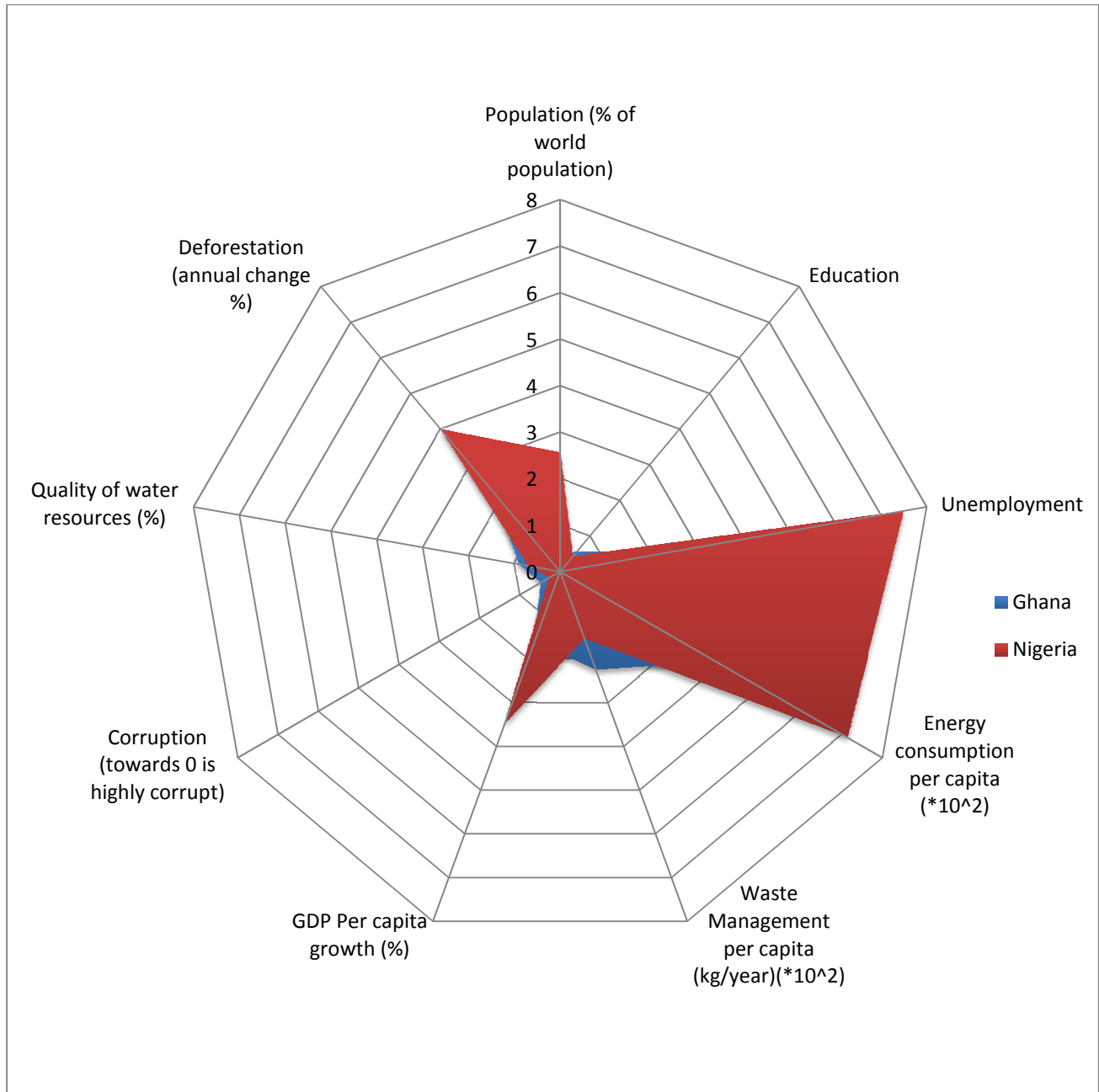
SUSTAINABILITY MODEL FROM NIGERIAN AND GHANAIAN PERSPECTIVE
